Tim will enhance his presentation with many of his photographs of rivers.

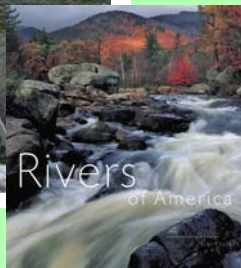
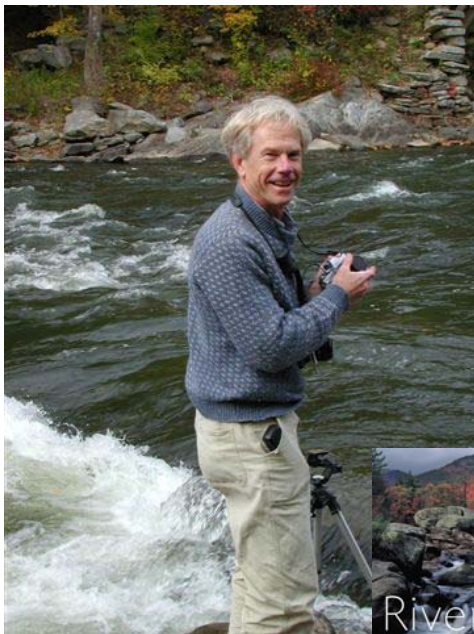
